Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1 - Dive into Kona: Coffee, History, and Time-Tested Tastes

We'll then shuttle up to coffee country, perched on volcanic slopes, visiting the historic Painted Church and an older coffee plantation. Tonight's cozy spot is at the Manago Hotel in Captain Cook, offering stellar views over Kealakekua Bay. Cap off the day with a feast at Hawaii's oldest restaurant, a culinary gem since 1917, serving up Hawaiian-style delights.

Day 2 - Paddle and Pedal Paradise: Kayaking and Downhill Bliss



Shuttle out of the bay, cross vast lava fields, and kick off an afternoon ride to the former plantation town of Pahala, where you'll bed down in historic plantation buildings. Along the way, visit Na'alehu, the southernmost town in the USA, and savor Hawaiian Sweetbreads. Dinner - Delights prepared by our hosts with locally sourced goodness.

Sleep: Pahala Plantation







Day 3 - Goddess of Fire Beckons: Cycling to Volcano with a Splash of Wine

Today, Tūtū Pele calls! Embark on a gradual uphill ride through macadamia groves, the Ka'u Desert, and rainforests to reach Kilauea Volcano. Pause for a wine tasting at Volcano Winery before settling into a hotel dating back to 1937 in Volcano Village. Cap off the day with dinner at the local favorite, Lava Rock Cafe.

Ride: 25 mi, Land: long slow climb Eat: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Sleep: Kilauea Lodge



Day 4 - Your Volcano Playground: Free Day at Volcano National Park

Unleash your adventurer! Explore Volcano National Park, hike across the crater floor of Kilauea Iki, wander through the Thurston Lava Tube, or marvel at the petroglyphs at Pu'u Loa. Alternatively, bask in relaxation around the lodge, soak in the hot tub, or take a stroll through the rainforest trails.



Meeting & Flights:

Your group will meet in Kailua Kona on Day 1.

Fly into Kailua Kona (KOA) before 7 am on Day 1 Fly out of Kailua Kona (KOA) after 12 noon on Day 6

Note: Arriving the day before maybe required for many flights to the Big Island.

Route Conditions:

The entire ride is on paved roads, with some stretches on narrow lanes. Traffic is moderate to light. The route is suitable for performance road, sport road and touring bikes. Terrain is hilly, small coastal hills in the beginning, with some larger climbs in the later part while we are on the old volcanoes.

Passport, Visa and Travel Documents:

Passports are not required for US citizens or US Green Card holders. Citizens of other countries should check with the nearest US Embassy to see if you can enter with an ESTA or require a visa. We strongly recommend looking into this well in advance of your tour, as visa processing times can sometimes be quite long. To locate the nearest US Embassy visit: https://www.usembassy.gov/.
